Notes on Gift Aid:

1. You can cancel this Declaration at any time by notifying the Trust.
2. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the Trust reclaims, you can cancel your declaration.
3. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
4. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the Trust or refer to help sheet IR65 on the HMRC web site.
5. Please notify the Trust if you change your name or address.
6. The Trust must be able to identify any gifts from you in order to reclaim the tax. A personal cheque or a standing order in the same name are the usual means of doing this. Please note that a Gift Aid declaration may not be in joint names.
