

The Aim

The aim of all our groups is to hear and obey God's word by studying it together, and so encourage one another to grow in faith and to reach out in love.

Your Group

Each group consists of eight to twelve people, including two or three leaders, and meets weekly. Homegroups, **HUB** and **iHUB** meet on Wednesday evenings, morning groups for women meet on Tuesday or Thursday mornings and for men on Tuesday mornings.

The Format

Meetings include a discussion on a Bible passage (sometimes in parallel with the Sunday morning or evening sermon series), as well as optional group prayer and some informal time together.

Commitment

The more people give themselves to regular attendance, application of God's word and a willingness to care for each other, the greater the benefit to the whole group. We therefore ask you to give weekly attendance a top priority.

Church Prayer Meeting

One Wednesday most months the above groups join with other church members for a central church prayer meeting in St Andrew the Great.

Evening Bible Study Groups

Homegroups

These are for men and women aged 21+ and at all stages. They meet on most Wednesday evenings at homes in and around Cambridge, often with a geographical bias. Groups are coordinated by John & Sara Anstead (844537) and Mark Ashton (518218).

HUB

HUB is for 20s-30s (including postgrads) and is especially appreciated by people new to the church who wish to meet a wider group of people at a similar stage in life. On Wednesdays **HUB** starts with a meal before dividing into Bible study groups. On Sunday evenings there are interactive events with discussion time. **HUB** meets in the church building and is coordinated by Kay Dawson (319066).

iHUB

iHUB is for internationals in their 20s-30s (including postgrads). **iHUB** meets on Wednesday evenings at a home in Cambridge from 7.30-9.30pm and includes dinner. **iHUB** is coordinated by James Poole (700429).

Morning Bible Study Groups

Women's Bible Study Groups

There are groups on a Tuesday or a Thursday morning (one for international women). Each group has a supervised crèche for young children. The women's groups are coordinated by Kay Dawson (319066).

Men's Early Morning Bible Study

MEMBS meets at St Andrew the Great on Tuesdays at 7.15am (7.00am for breakfast) and is always finished by 8.00am. It is coordinated by Jonny Kingsman (232418).
