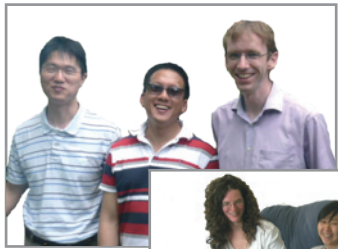

## The Aim

The aim of all our groups is to hear and obey God's word by studying it together, and so encourage one another to grow in faith and to reach out in love.

## Your Group

Groups usually consist of about eight to twelve people, including two or three leaders, and meet weekly. Homegroups, HUB and iHUB meet on Wednesday evenings, morning groups for women meet on Tuesday or Thursday mornings and for men on Tuesday mornings.

## The Format

Meetings include a discussion on a Bible passage (sometimes in parallel with the Sunday morning or evening sermon series), as well as group prayer and some informal time together.

## Commitment

The more people give themselves to regular attendance, application of God's word and a willingness to care for each other, the greater the benefit to the whole group. We therefore ask you to give weekly attendance a high priority.

## Church Prayer Meeting

One Wednesday evening each month the groups join with other church members for a central church prayer meeting in St Andrew the Great.



## Evening Bible Study Groups

### Homegroups

For adult men and women. These meet on Wednesdays in homes, often with a geographical bias, and welcome people of all ages and at all stages.

### HUB

For 20s-30s including postgraduates. Meets on Wednesdays in the church building starting with a meal. Coordinated by Kay Dawson (kay.dawson@stag.org).

### iHUB

For international postgraduates and 20s-30s. Meets on Wednesdays at the Round Church. Coordinated by James Poole (james.poole@stag.org).

### Men's Early Morning Bible Study (MEMBS)
