ARENA (CHRISTIANITY EXPLORED)

CHILDREN'S GROUPS

During the 10.00am service all children stay in for about 15 minutes and then go out to groups according to age. Now and then these groups are combined for Children's Activities. From time-to-time all ages remain together for a short, lively, child-friendly service called a Family Service.
